



Counter Terrorism Security Co-ordinator (CT SecCo)

Policy

1. Introduction

1.1 The role of the Counter Terrorism Security Coordinator (CT SecCo) is to develop a holistic security plan with a view to minimise, manage and mitigate risk in respect of a policed event or operation in support of a Gold Commander's strategy.

2 Scope

2.1 This policy covers the selection, training, coordination and operational deployment of CT SecCos across Surrey and Sussex Police. Its purpose is to provide a consistent approach to the deployment of suitably qualified CT SecCos to operations or events requiring their specialism.

3. Policy Statement

3.1 Operations Command will maintain a cadre of suitably qualified and accredited CT SecCos to discharge its responsibilities in accordance with Authorised Professional Practice (APP), to meet the strategic demands of both Forces. These officers will be appropriately selected, trained and equipped to deliver a consistent standard of service to Gold Commanders.

3.2 The deployment of a CT SecCo will be in accordance with the Guidance contained in the CT SecCo deployment and guidance document.
