

**Terms and Conditions of Entry on to Surrey Police property during the Open Day (Event) 11<sup>th</sup> September 2022**

Surrey Police places great importance on the safety of its visitors and endeavours to ensure that the high standards set by us are complied with by all those on the estate. We are only prepared to allow entry to the event to those visitors who are willing to comply with the event regulations set out below.

We are sure that you will wish to assist us in ensuring the event and facilities therein remain a safe place in which to enjoy a fun and exciting experience. To assist in ensuring your safety, CCTV is in operation in most areas of the estate.

1. All persons entering Surrey Police HQ, Mount Browne are admitted subject to the following event regulations. Any person (or the entire group) who does not comply with these Regulations may be removed from the event by either Surrey Police Personnel or Police Officers. This is without prejudice to any claim that Surrey Police may have against such a person or persons arising out of their actions. Whilst on our premises, all visitors must comply with any instructions given to them by event Personnel or Police Officers.
2. Surrey Police reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to refuse admission to the event, ban from entry to the event, or remove from the event, any person or entire group who:
  - 2.1. has behaved in or in the vicinity of the event in a manner which, in the opinion of Surrey Police, has, or is likely to affect the safety and enjoyment of other visitors or staff;
  - 2.2. uses threatening, abusive or insulting words or behaviour or in any way provokes or behaves in a manner which may provoke a breach of the peace.
3. All persons entering the event must hold a valid admission ticket that must be retained at all times and submitted for inspection if required by Surrey Police personnel. Any person attempting to gain admission to the event or being found inside the event without a valid ticket may be ejected from the event. All tickets are non-transferable.
4. No child or children under the age of 12 will be admitted to the event unless they are accompanied by an adult, who shall be 18 years or over and such child or children whilst on site must remain under the control or supervision of that adult at all times.

4.1. Surrey Police, in its absolute discretion, may raise the age on an individual basis for the requirement of accompaniment by an adult should it be deemed necessary in the interests of safety and security.

5. Pets or animals of any nature are expressly prohibited in the event (except for guide dogs, hearing dogs and registered assistance dogs) without the express permission of Surrey Police
6. To prevent offensive weapons or dangerous articles from being taken into the event, visitors are admitted to the event subject to a condition that, if requested to do so, they will allow themselves and/or their belongings to be searched. It is prohibited to bring into the event any weapons, fireworks, smoke bombs, glass bottles or other articles, which may cause injury. The throwing of any article which could cause injury or annoyance is strictly prohibited.

6.1. Any person found to be in possession of an article deemed to be offensive or dangerous will be immediately escorted from the event, potentially arrested and be open to prosecution.

6.2. The entire group with whom the individual at 6.1 above is a member may also, at the event Silvers discretion, be denied entry or escorted from the event

7. The consumption of intoxicating liquors is NOT permitted anywhere within the event. Accordingly, intoxicating liquor may not be taken into the event and any persons found possessing alcohol, or who appears to be under the influence of alcohol may be refused admission or escorted from the event. The use of illegal substances is strictly prohibited and any persons found possessing, using or who appear to be under the influence of illegal substances will be refused admission, escorted from the event, liable to arrest and prosecution.
8. Surrey Police will endeavour to ensure that as many attractions as possible are available for use by visitors. However, Surrey Police reserves the right to make available, close and/or change the programme of attractions with or without notice if, at any time, it is deemed necessary or appropriate to do so.
9. Unnecessary noise, (such as that from the use of radio sets, mobile phones, video cameras and other electrical equipment) or any behaviour likely to cause annoyance to other visitors or confusion of any kind is not permitted in any part of the event.

10. The climbing of or standing upon fences, barriers, walls, safety fences, exhibits or buildings is strictly prohibited. Surrey Police reserves the right to prosecute any person found damaging or defacing any or any part of the grounds, fences, barriers, walls, exhibits, fabrics or buildings.
11. Surrey Police accepts no responsibility for any loss and/or damage however arising whilst on our premises (including that which might arise as result of any breach of contract) including any distress, inconvenience or anxiety caused during the course of any attraction or exhibit undertaken and/or during evacuation from the event or fire or security precaution.
12. From time to time Surrey Police or other authorised parties carry out photography and/or video recording at the event which may feature visitors. By accepting these Regulations, you agree that Surrey Police or any authorised party may use such images in perpetuity in any promotional, advertising or publicity material in any format whatsoever. You further agree that copyright in these materials rests with Surrey Police or such authorised party (as the case may be).
13. Smoking and or vaping is strictly prohibited across the whole event and Mount Browne site
