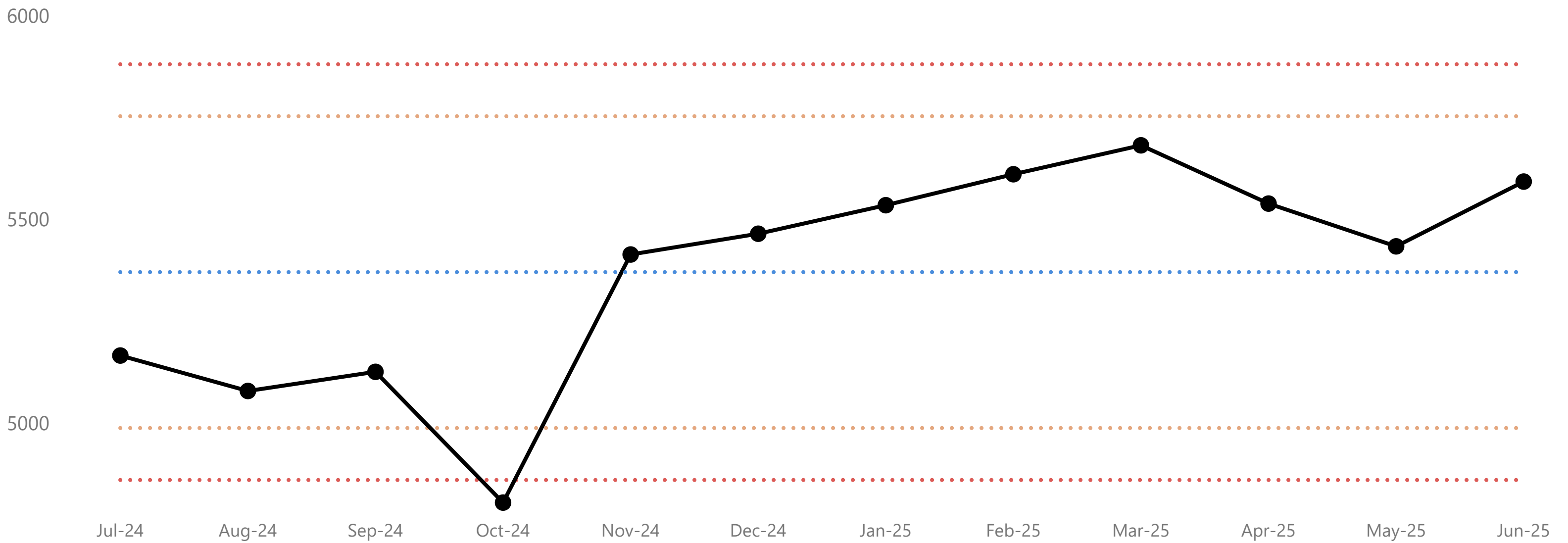

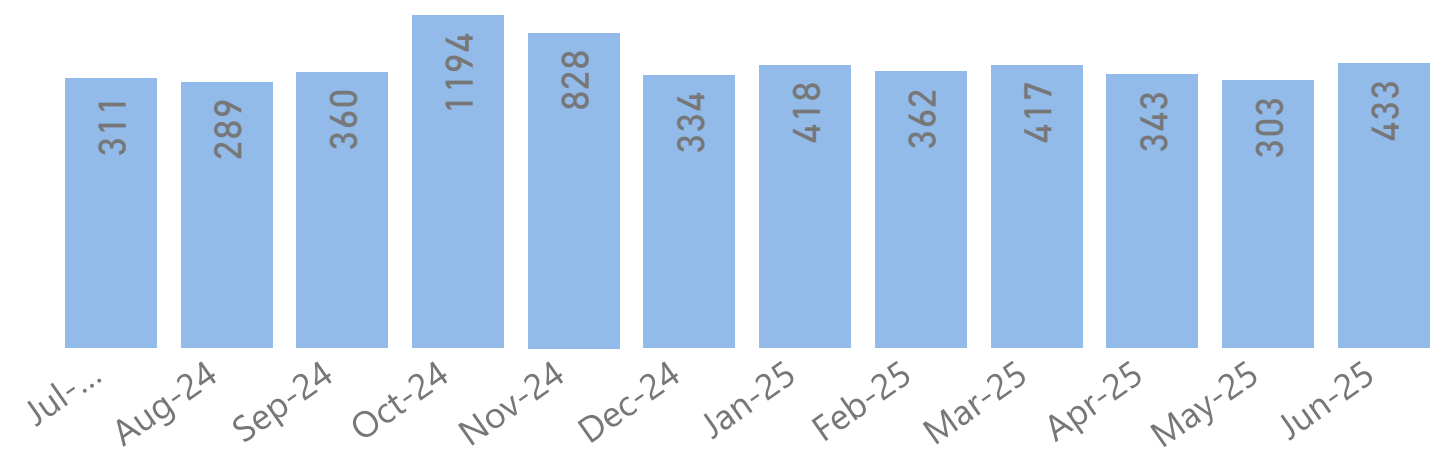

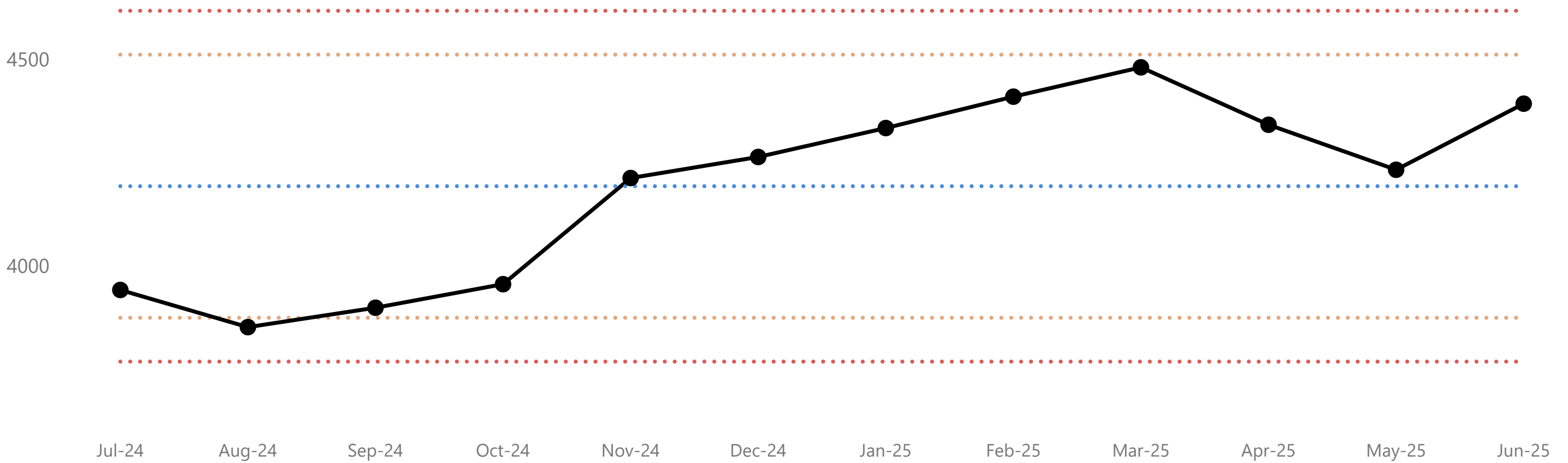
### Latest 12 Monthly Volumes

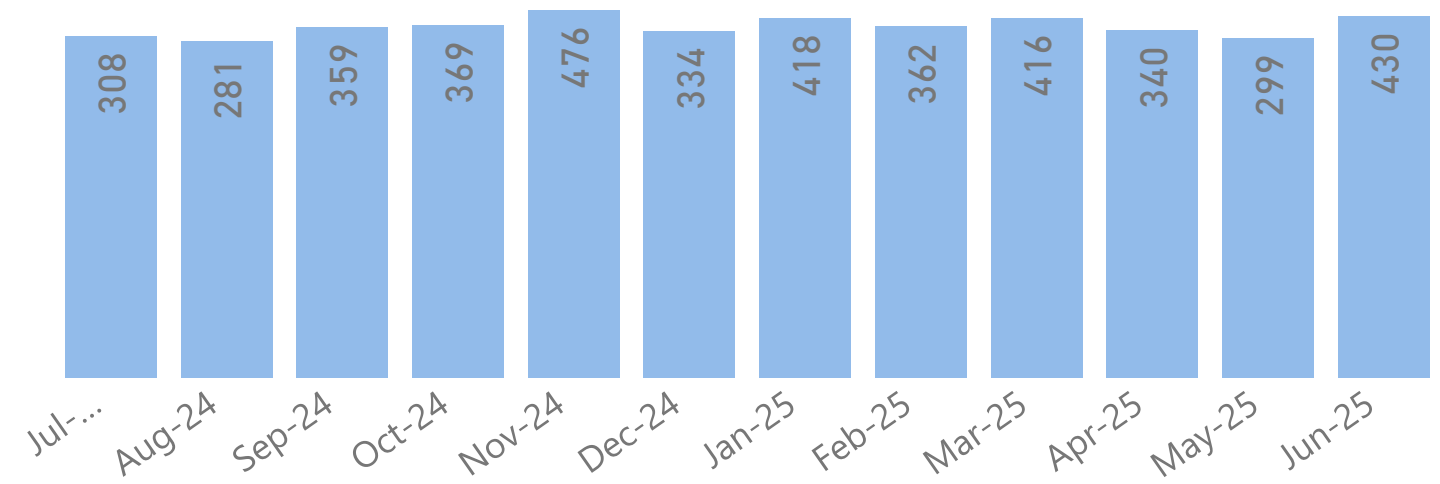

### Latest 12 Monthly Volumes



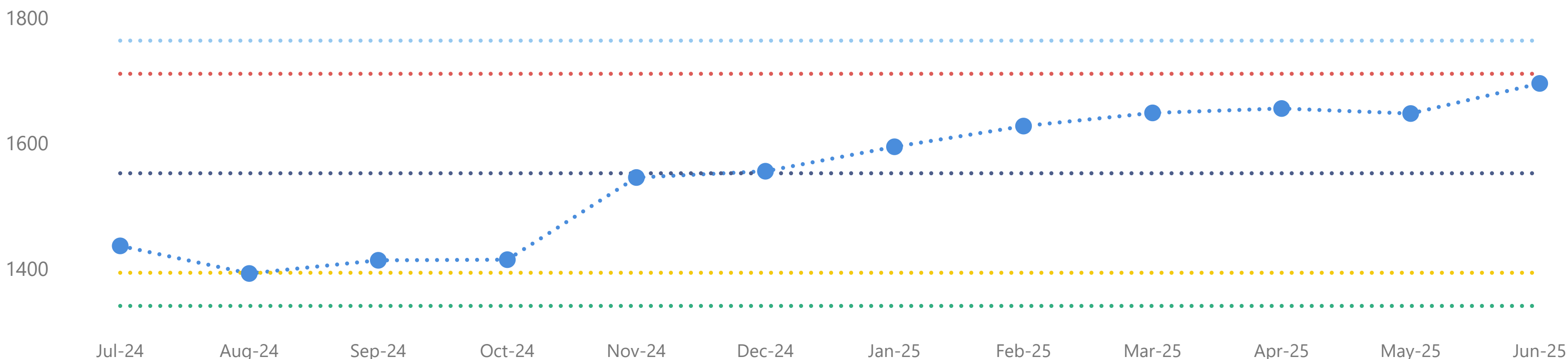

#### Rolling 12 Month Trend

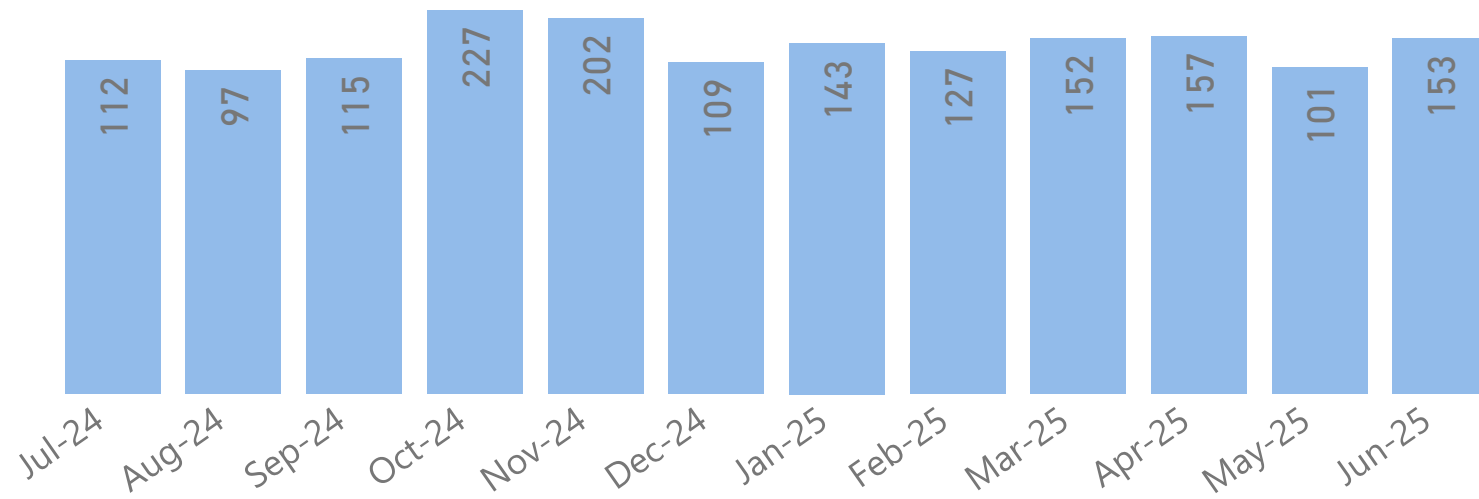

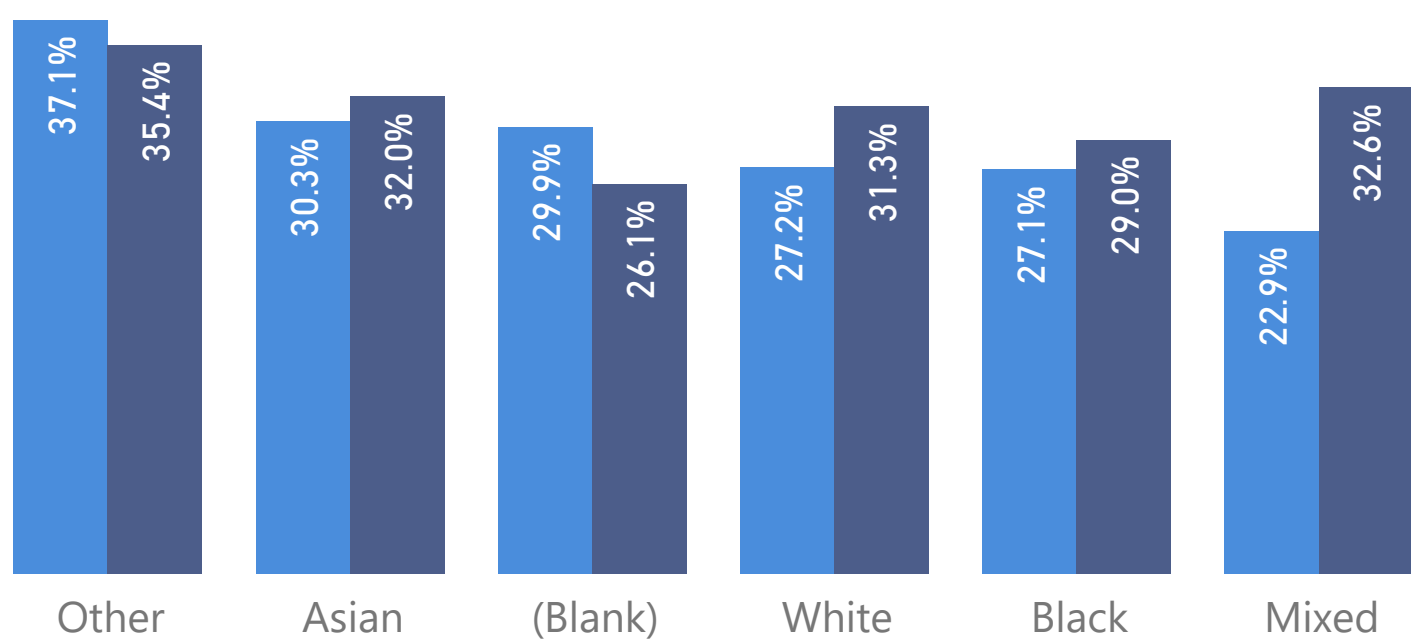
#### Latest 12 Monthly Volumes

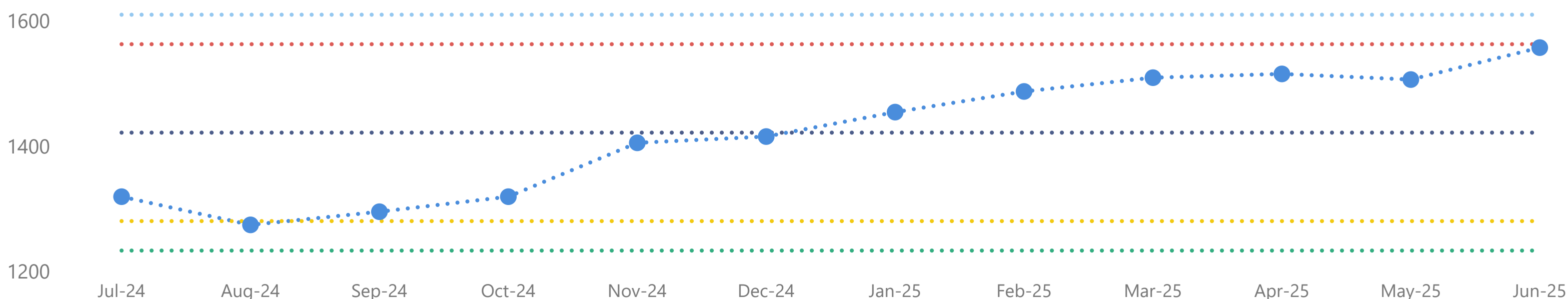

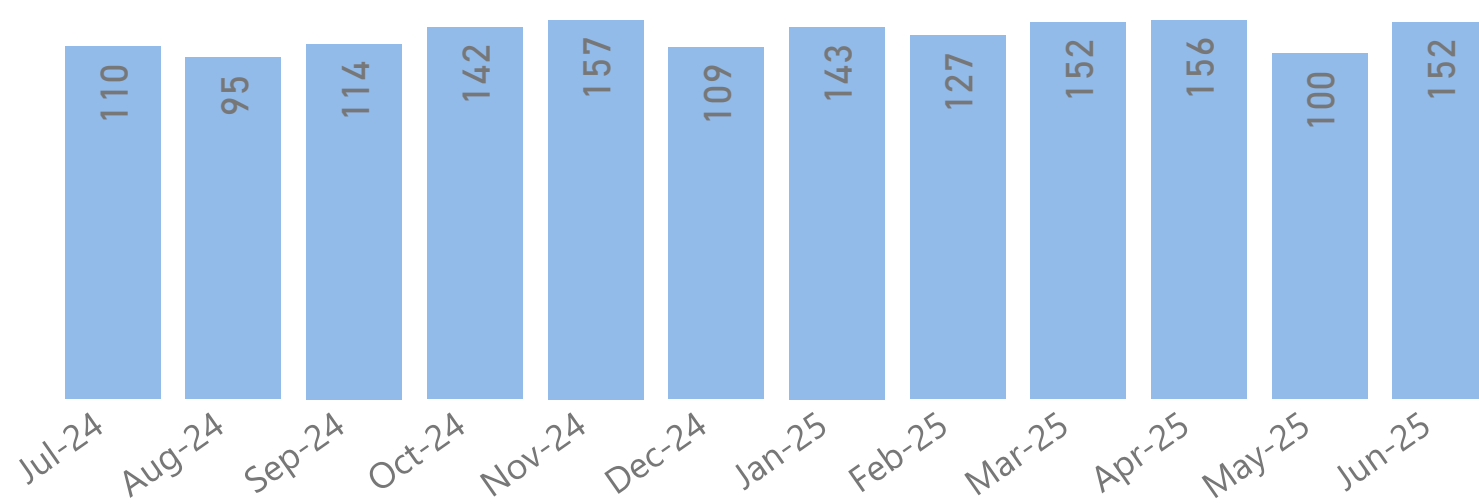

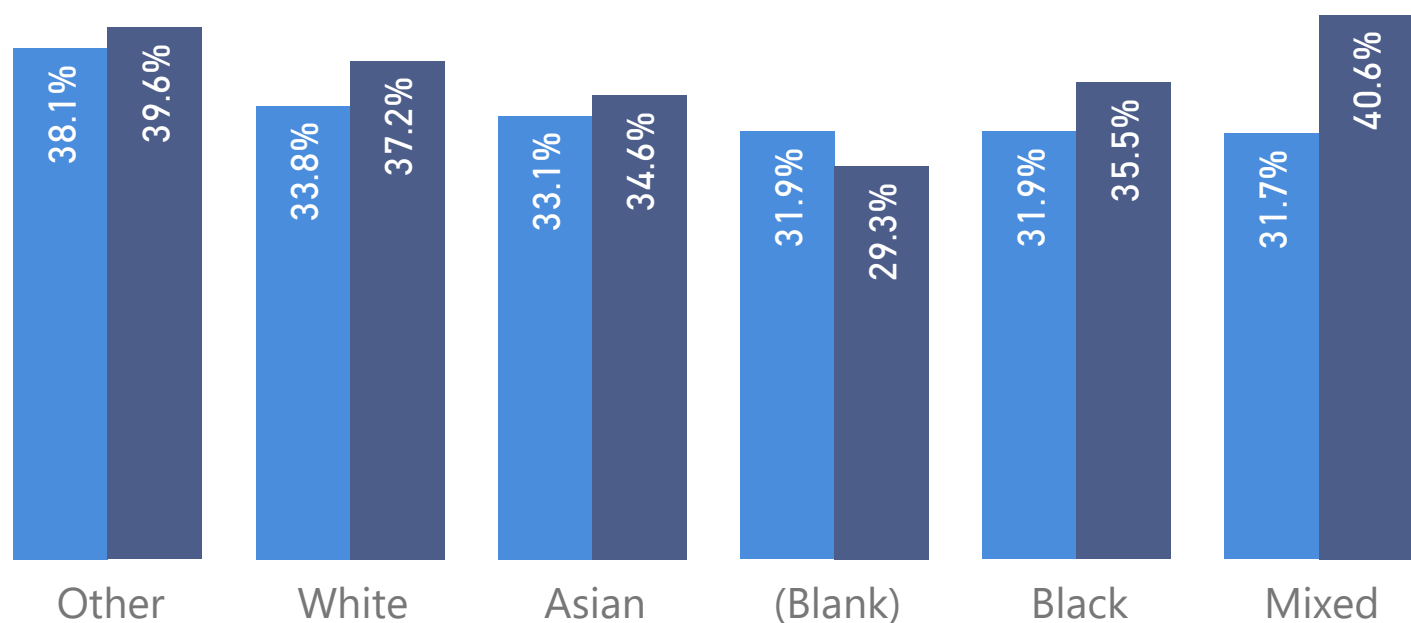

## Stops By Powers and Stop Initiation

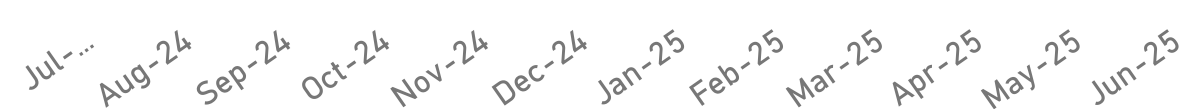

In the latest rolling 12 months to 30-Jun-2025, the most stops had an initiation reason of Self-Initiated, with 2385 stops. This equates to 42.65% of all stops. This compares to 2189 stops in the previous 12 months, which equates to 41.21% of stops, an increase of -1.44%

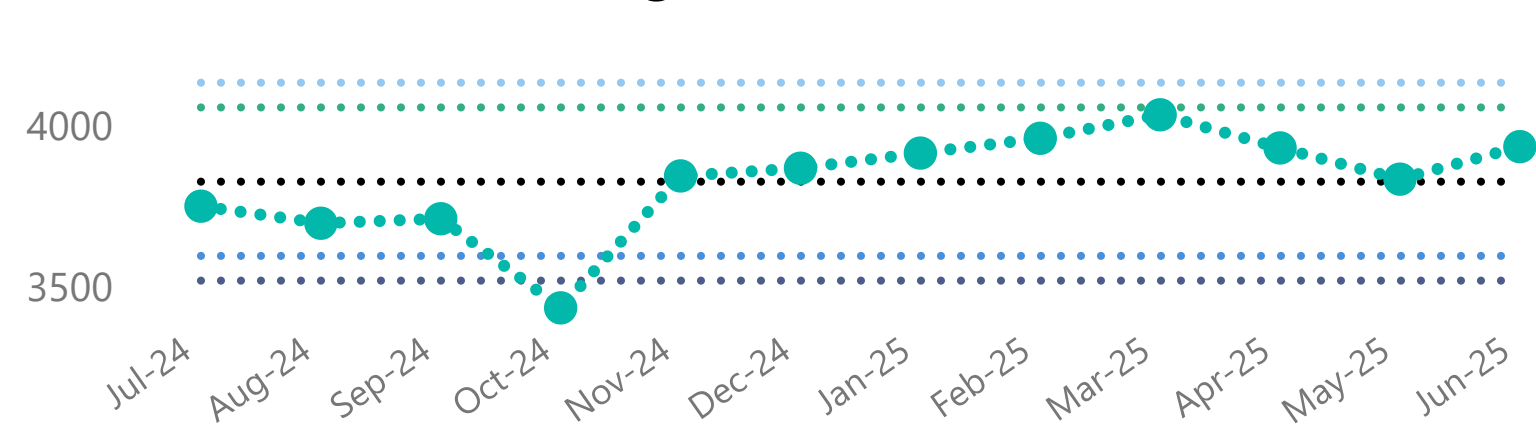

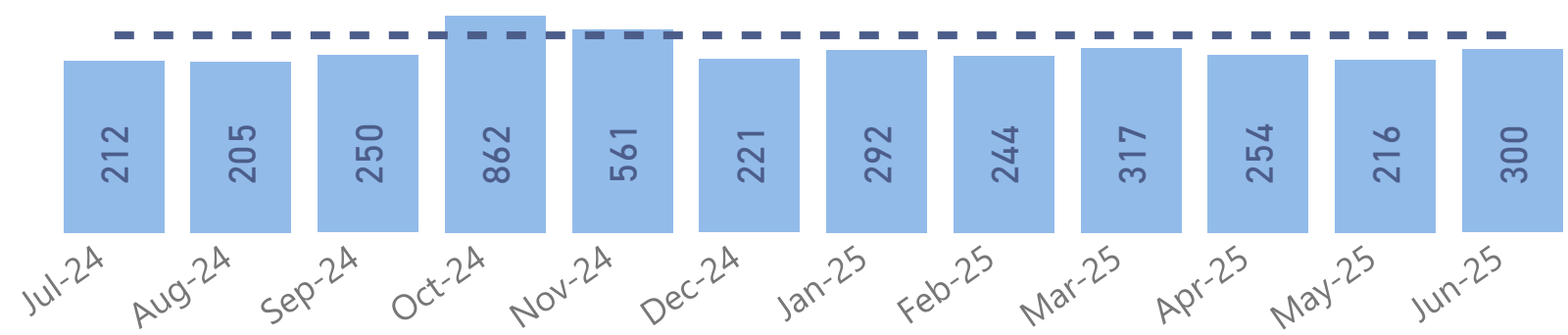

Rolling 12 Month Trend



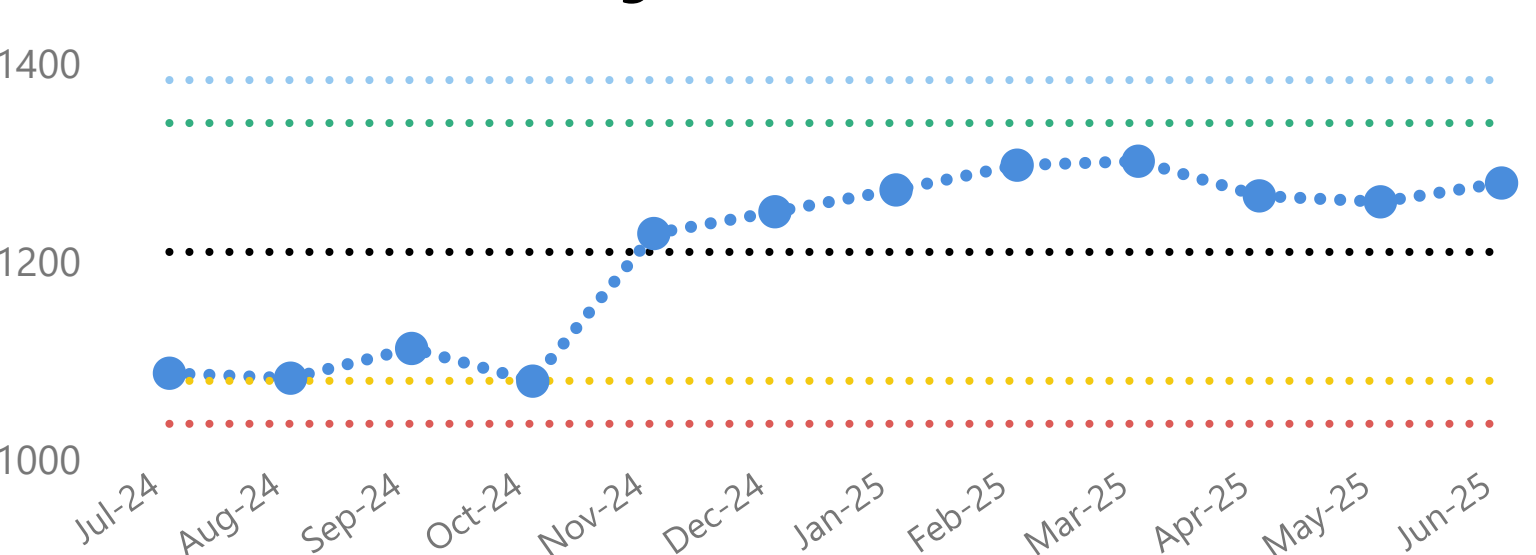

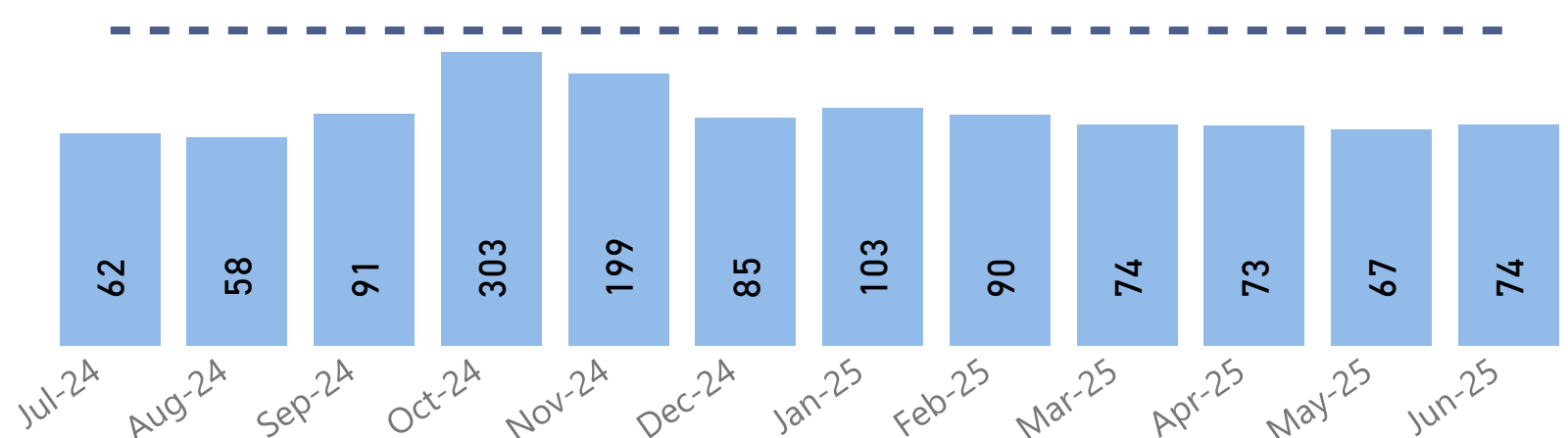
## Rolling Year Volumes - Minority ethnic

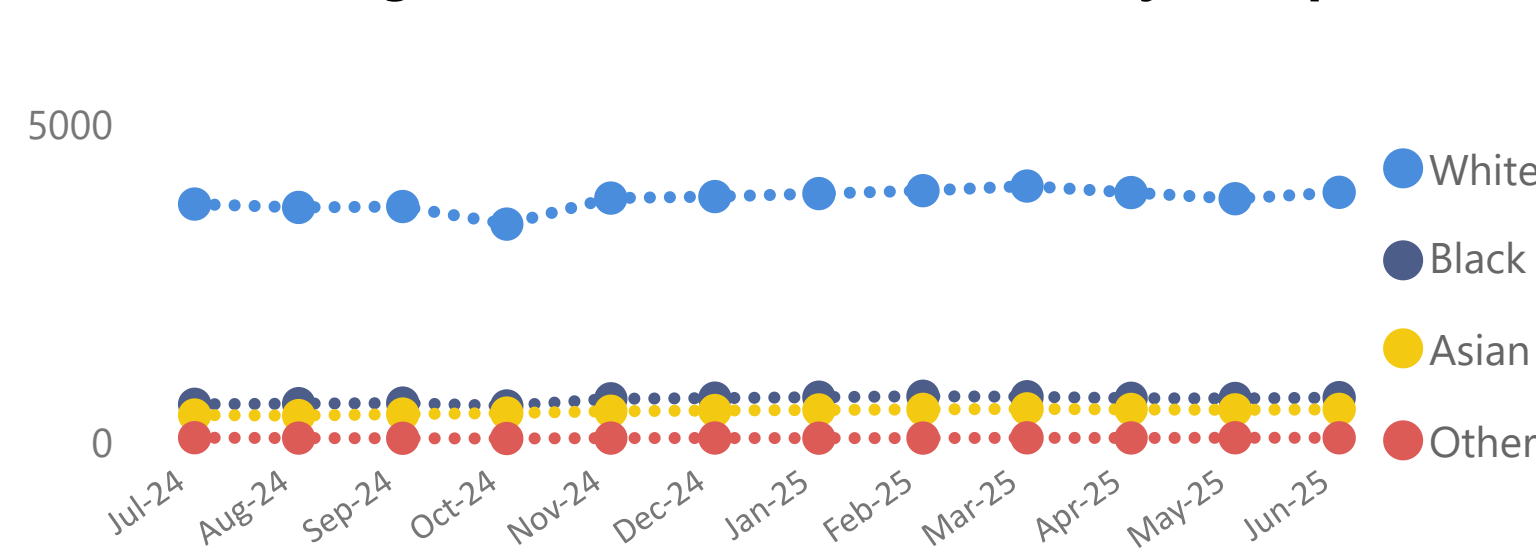
Rolling 12 Month Trend



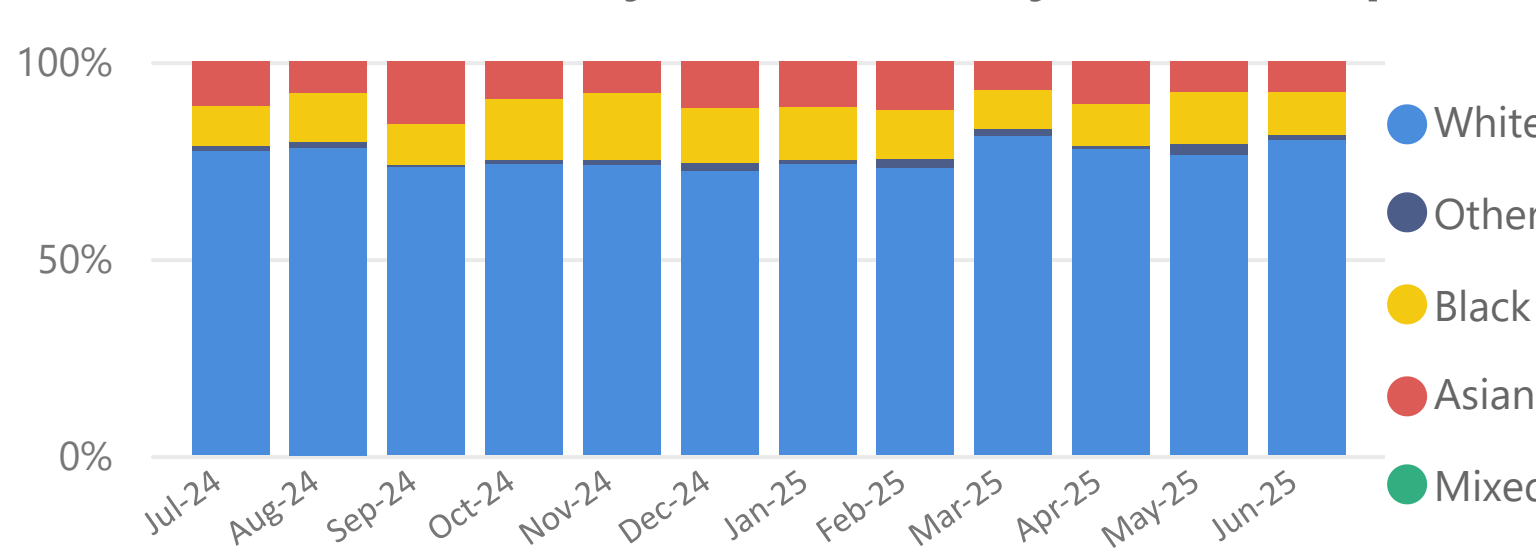
Total Stops ODE BAME Stops Average



Rolling 18 Month Trend - All Ethnicity Groups



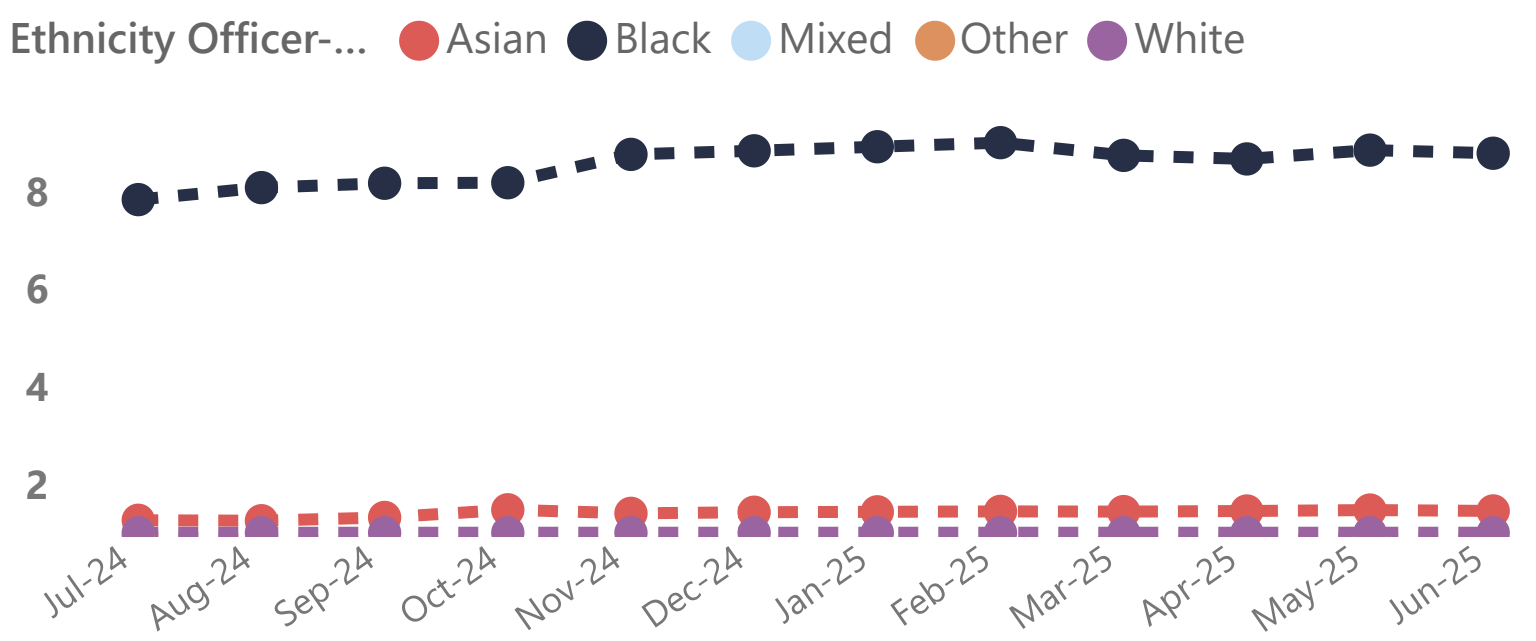
Latest 12 Monthly Volumes (%) by Ethnic Group

Rolling 24 month Ethnic Dispro Trend



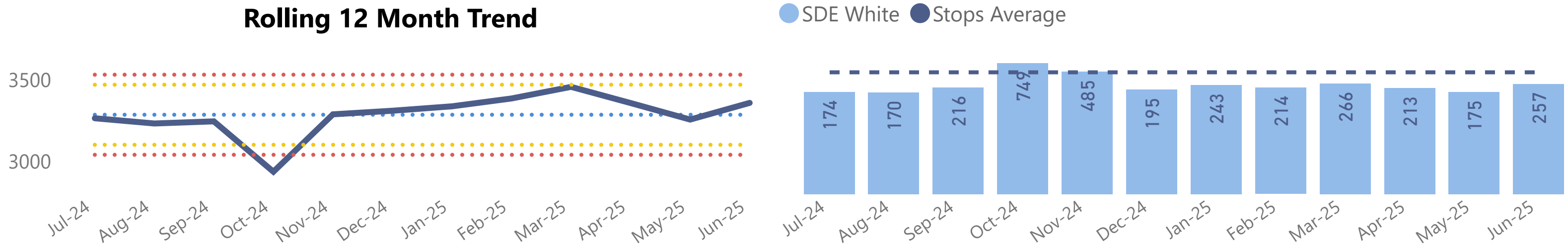

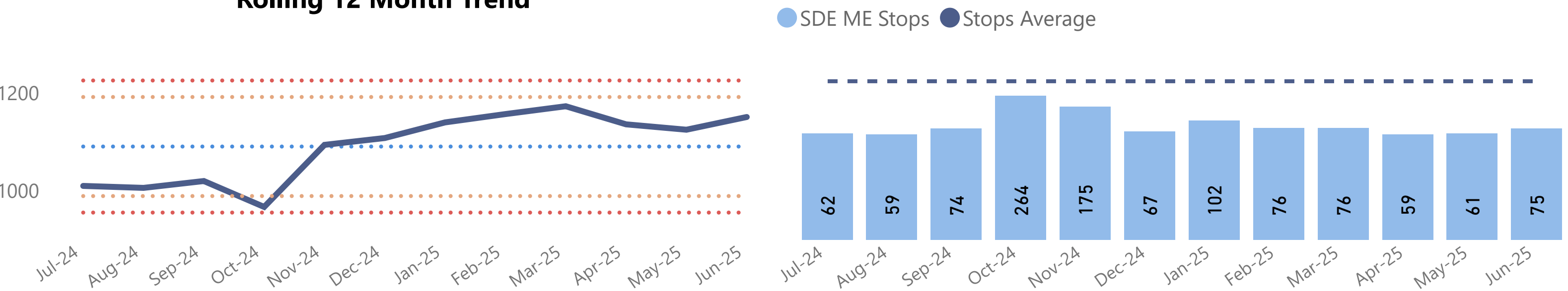
Rolling 12 Month Trend



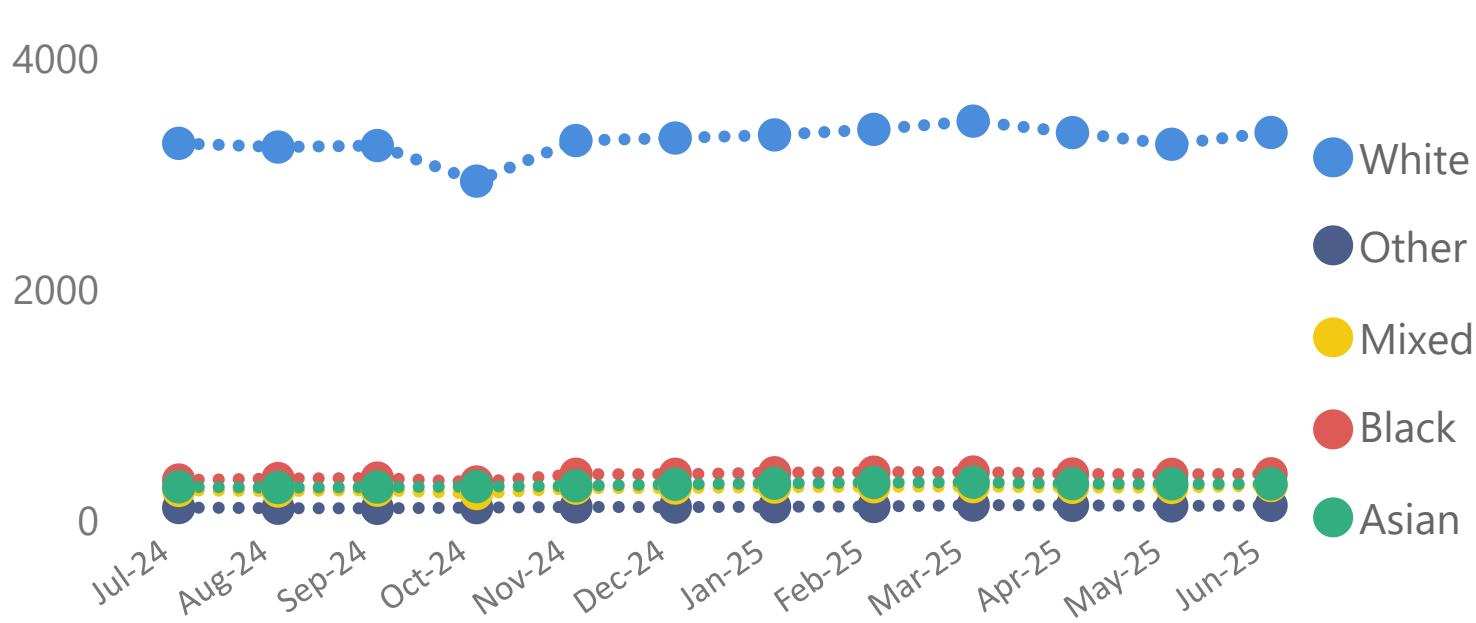

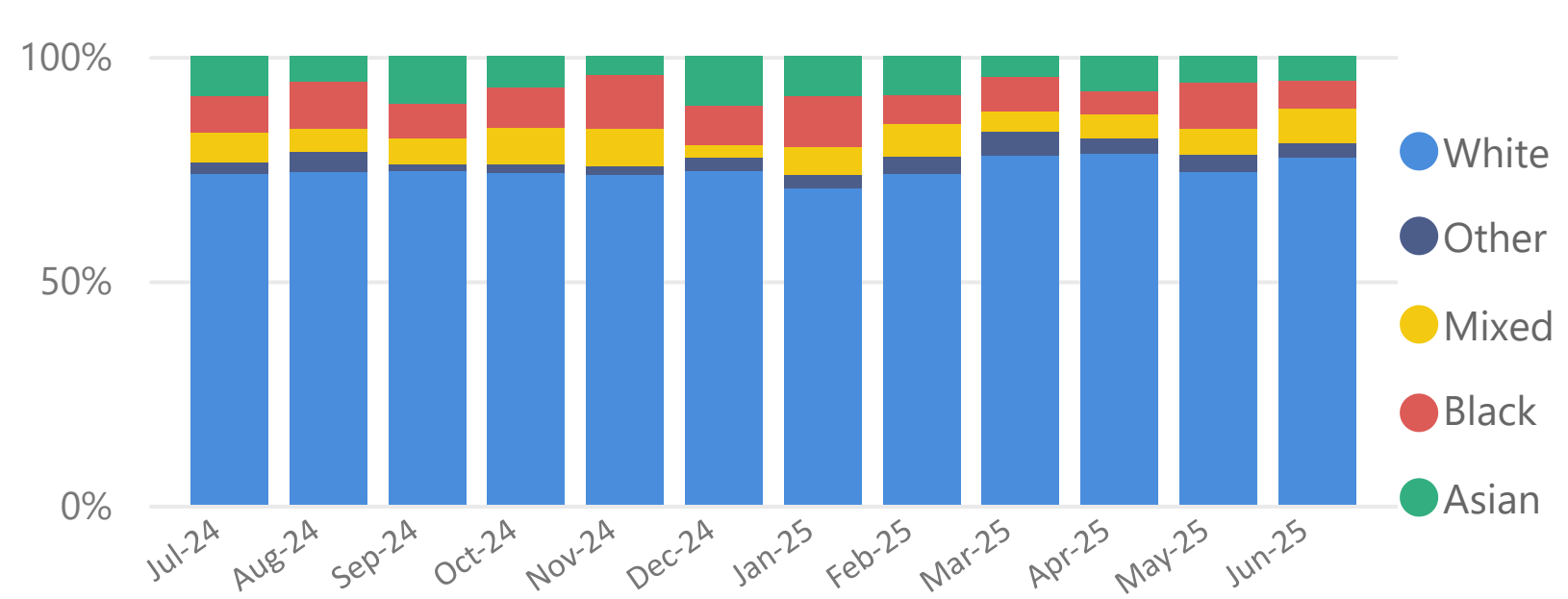
Rolling 12 Month Trend



Rolling 18 Month Trend - All Ethnicity Groups



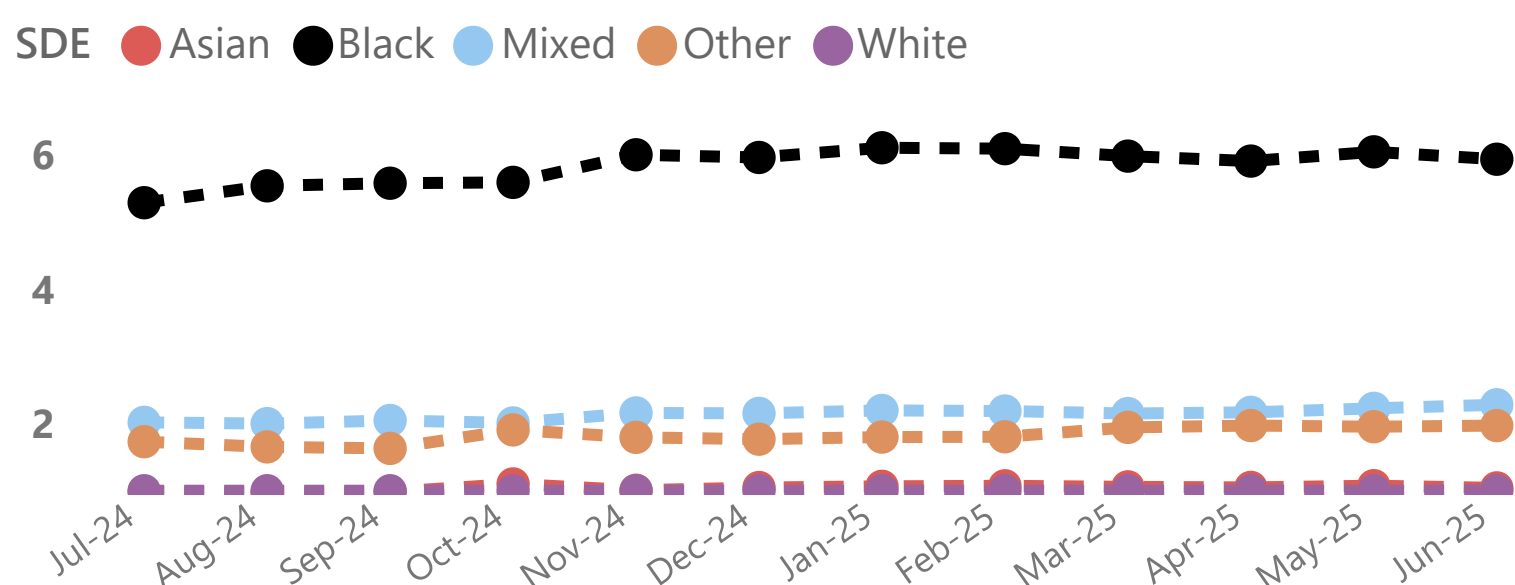
Latest 12 Monthly Volumes (%) by Ethnic Group

Rolling 24 month Ethnic Dispro Trend



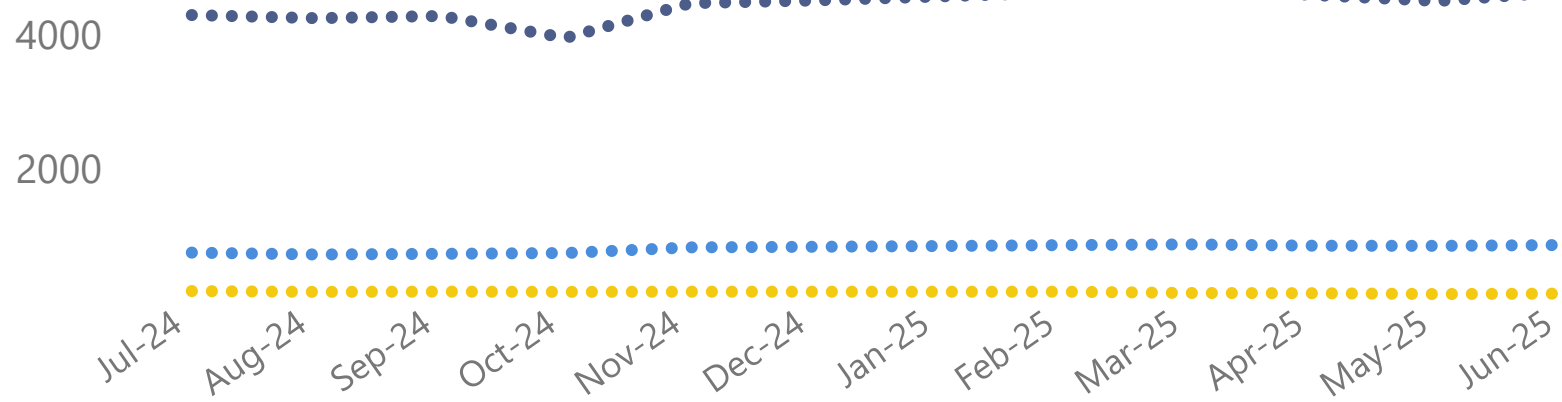

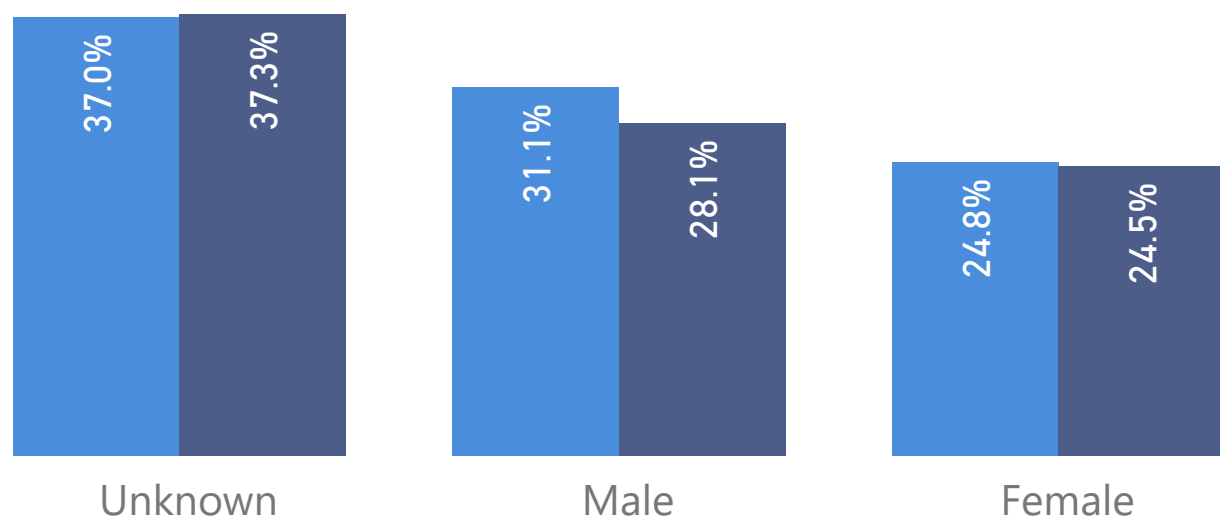

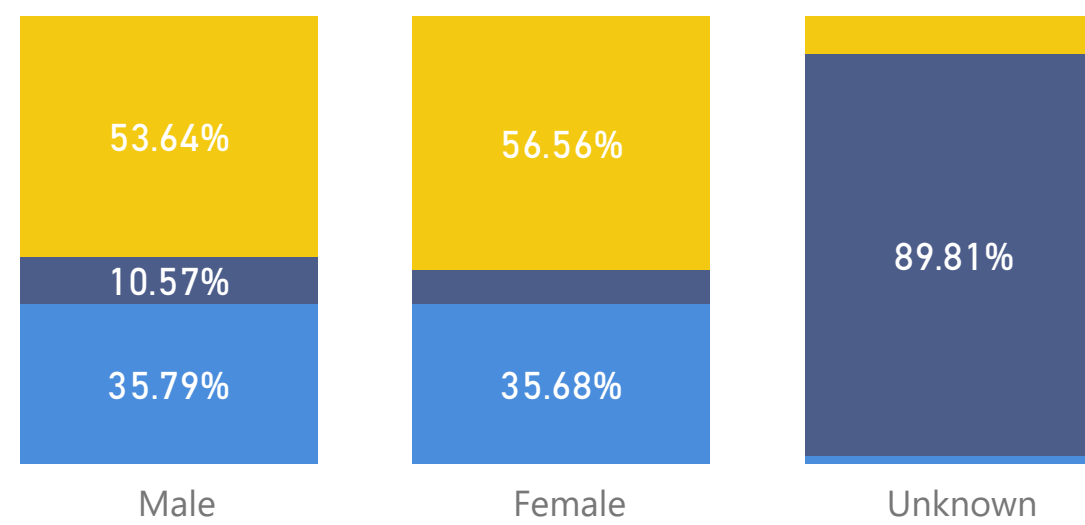

Rolling Year Stops By Gender

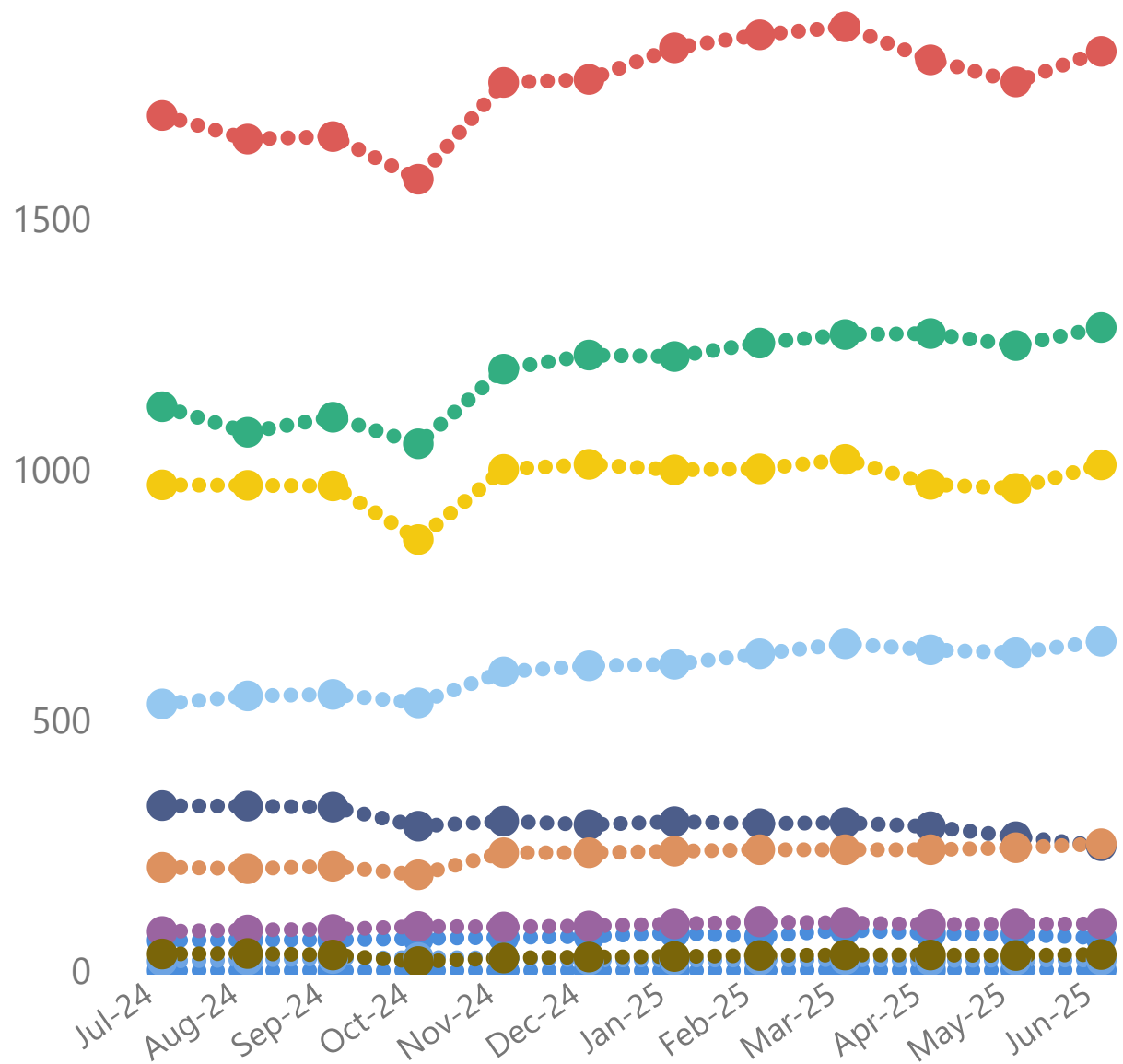

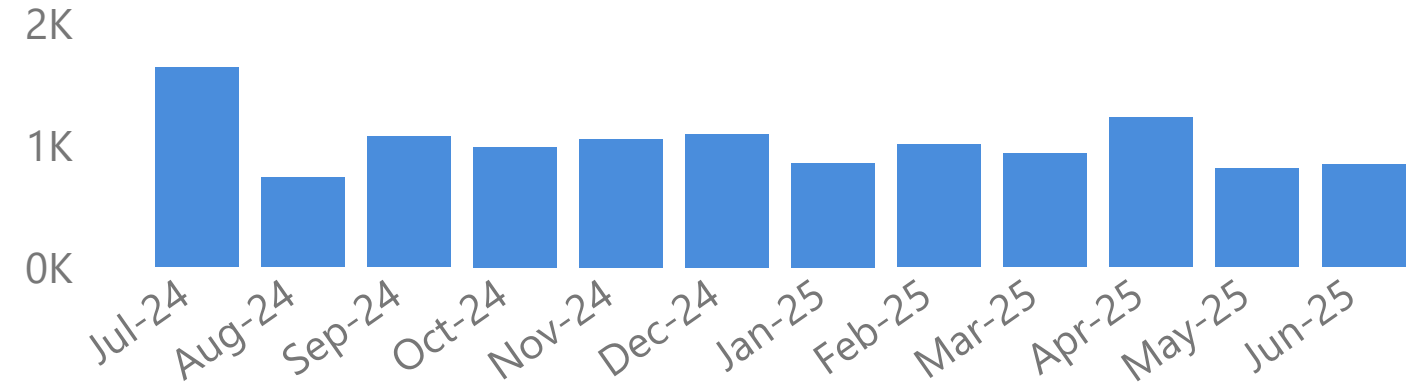
## S163 Rolling Year

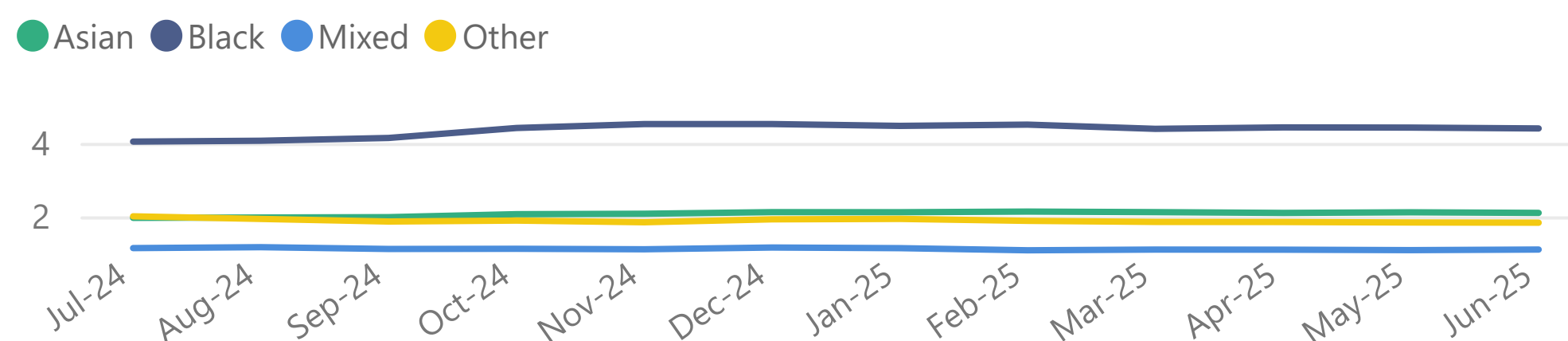

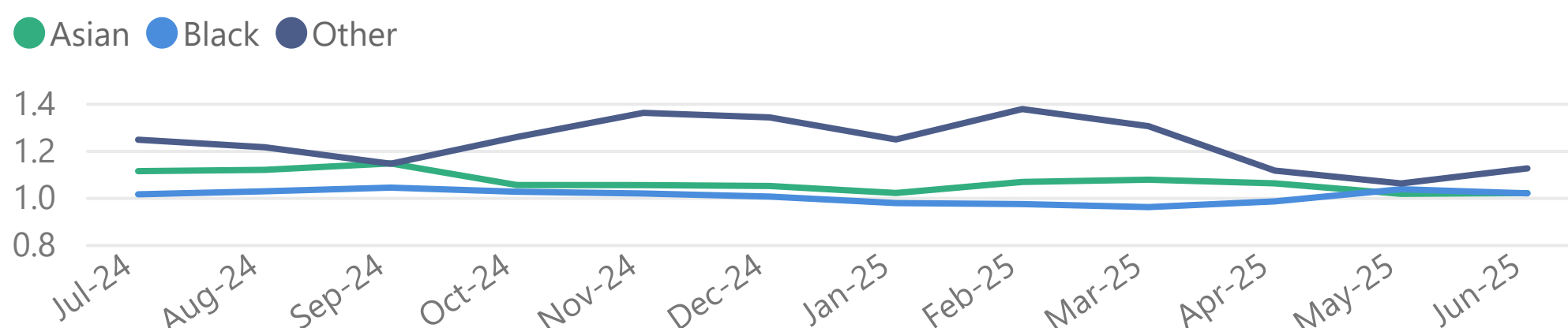
